

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 329

**AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE
CENTRAL CONTRA COSTA SANITARY DISTRICT
ADOPTING AN UPDATED SCHEDULE OF
CAPACITY FEES, RATES AND CHARGES**

Pursuant to Central Contra Costa Sanitary District Code Chapter 6.12, Ordinance No. 329 (uncodified) adopts an updated "Schedule of Capacity Fees, Rates and Charges" that sets the Capacity Fee as \$8,192 per Residential Unit Equivalent, which is an increase of the Gravity Capacity Fees from \$7,200 to \$8,182 per Residential Unit Equivalent, and a decrease in the Capacity Fee for those parcels in portions of the District where wastewater is conveyed to the treatment plant by one or more pump stations from \$9,211 to \$8,182 per Residential Unit Equivalent. resulting. The new fee will become effective July 1, 2023.
