We are a special district responsible for the collection and treatment of wastewater in a 182-square-mile service area in Contra Costa County, for approximately 488,900 residents and more than 3,000 businesses.

Our 274 employees operate and maintain more than 1,540 miles of pipe and clean and disinfect an average of 44 million gallons a day. We are governed by a five-member Board of Directors.
