INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT

DEFINITION

Integrated Pest Management (IPM) is a science-based strategy and decision-making process that provides effective, long-term pest control while emphasizing pest prevention and the use of non-chemical pest management practices through physical, cultural, biological and, when appropriate, chemical control methods to effectively manage pests with minimal risk to public health and the environment.

POLICY

It will be the District's policy to humanely manage pests using IPM principles and techniques in all pest control activities conducted by staff, vendors, and contractors in the District's properties, facilities, and collection system.
